The Good News is under the leadership of **Pastor Chris Simmons**, several churches and organizations have assisted in raising the money for the construction of this wonderful new building called "The Kitchen". This 9,600 square-foot structure is the centerpiece of job training, business incubation and homeless meal preparation with these amenities:

- 6,800 square feet of open space for seating for community ministry
- 1,400 square feet of commercial grade kitchen space training, business incubation and homeless meal preparation with these amenities:
- 9,600 square foot facility
- 920 square feet of dedicated storage
- Dedicated men's and women's rest rooms with 6 toilets and 4 sinks
